

# What Is This Wristband Business All About . . .

It is about making sure your child gets their lunch choice!

Last school year, Chartwells implemented the wristband program at all elementary schools. It has been a great success and we have appreciated the support from the classroom teachers, staff and principals. We continue to tweak the program for the optimal success. Here is how you, as the parent, can help! Please take time to review the menu choices with your child.

## ***Late Arrival Guideline - IMPORTANT***

If your child is going to arrive late at school due to an appointment, you must call the school office in the morning by 9:00 am with your child's lunch selection. They will then be included in the lunch count and will be given their choice of entrée. If they arrive at school after 9:30 am, and you have not called in their choice of entrée, they will be offered a PB&J Uncrustable at lunch.

Teachers are responsible for the distribution of the proper color band to each student. If you are having trouble with your student not receiving the correct entrée or color band, please contact your classroom teacher.
