Dear Families,

Late Friday afternoon, Governor Evers [directed](#) that all public and private 4K-12 schools are mandated to shut down by Wednesday, March 18th.

Beginning Tuesday, March 17, the Menasha Joint School District will close to students until further notice. Online/At home instruction will start on **Thursday, March 19th**. In an effort to keep your children engaged during this uncertain time and to maintain equitable learning opportunities, we have established the following online/at home instructional plan:
