The Menasha Joint School District provides a wide variety of programs and services for children with disabilities. Services/programs have been provided in pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade for students with intellectual, specific learning, emotional behavioral, speech/language, physical, hearing and vision disabilities as well as autism, traumatic brain injury, and other health impairments.

While these programs are supported by local tax dollars, the District does receive some monies each year through the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act and Preschool Entitlement funds. Some of the programs/services funded under this act are:

Educational and consultation services of: School Psychologist, Speech/Language Pathologist, Occupational Therapist, Physical Therapist, Early Childhood Specialist, Vision Impaired Specialist, Hearing Impaired Specialist; staff development; and transportation for special education students.

The Menasha Joint School District will be submitting its grant proposals to the Department of Public Instruction this summer for the 2018/2019 school year.
