

Legal Notice – Vocational Education Opportunities

It is the policy of the Menasha Joint School District that no person may be denied admission to any public school in this district or be denied participation in, be denied benefits of, or be discriminated against in any curricular, extra-curricular, pupil service, recreational, vocational educational offerings, or other program or activity because of the person's race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, sex (including transgender status, change of sex or gender identity), disability, age (except as authorized by law), military status, or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability in any of its student programs and activities. This policy also prohibits discrimination as defined by Title IX of the Educational Amendments, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act, and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act. All courses, including Career and Technical Educational courses are available without discrimination based on the above.

The district encourages informal resolution of complaints under this policy. A formal complaint resolution procedure is available, however, to address allegations of violations of the policy in the Menasha Joint School District.
